## Key Achievements & Highlights



### 1. National and International Competitions:

Since November 2022, our surfers have participated in numerous national and international competitions, showcasing their talent and bringing home several accolades. Notably, our representation at the 2023 Asian Surfing Championships in Maldives resulted in bringing home the bronze medal, marking it a significant milestone for Sri Lankan surfing.

### 2. Junior Competitions and Rankings:

We have successfully organized several junior competitions over the past year, fostering young talent and creating a competitive environment. We are proud to announce the establishment of a junior competitor ranking system, which has already started to motivate our young surfers to achieve higher standards

#### 3. ISA Course Presenter:

In a significant milestone, we have secured Mr. Pat Renaurd, as the official course presenter from the International Surfing Association (ISA), to conduct ISA courses in Sri Lanka. This is a crucial step towards improving the training and certification of our surfers and coaches.

### 03. Lifesaving Classes:

We have conducted free lifesaving classes within certain surf villages in collaboration with the STF and Police Lifesaving Unit. These classes have trained locals and non-surfers in handling emergencies, thereby enhancing the safety of our surfing communities. This initiative has been instrumental in promoting safety and preparedness among our coastal communities, ensuring that help is readily available in times of need.

#### 5. ISA ILS Course Trainers:

We are also in the process of training two Sri Lankan individuals to become ILS course conductors. Their names and qualifications have been submitted for approval by the ISA, and we are elated & optimistic about having our own certified trainers soon.

### 4. Regional Alliances:

Our federation has formed & notably strengthened its position within the Asian Surfing Federation. We have also forged close alliances & worked closely with the Maldivian Surf Federation, Surf Federation of India & The Saudi Surfing Federation. These partnerships are vital for regional collaboration, exchange of knowledge, and joint initiatives that will benefit our surfers.

### 6. Sponsorships and Partnerships:

We have been able to obtain several key sponsorships and partnerships, providing short-term financial boosts and allowing us to invest more in athlete development and competition participation for certain events and tours. After extensive efforts and numerous conversations and lengthy negotiations with the ISA for several months, we are delighted to announce that we successfully organized an installment payment system for our dues of \$2,500. Completing these payments has been a significant achievement for us, reflecting our commitment and dedication to the growth of surfing in Sri Lanka. This heartfelt accomplishment was made possible through the unwavering support of our members and stakeholders, who have stood by us through this challenging journey.

### 3. Female Participation:

There is a pressing need to improve the participation of females in surfing. We must encourage more women to join the federation and take up surfing. Their involvement is essential for the growth and diversity of our sport. We are committed to creating a supportive and inclusive environment for female surfers and are actively working on initiatives to promote and encourage their participation.
